Expectations for BTA Students and Guests:

1. In order to keep balance between males and females, BTA students are encouraged to invite guests of their opposite gender.
2. All students and guests are expected to check in at their arrival.
3. Students and guests will not be allowed to leave prom and re-enter. Once students and guests leave they cannot return.
4. Only one guest contract can be issued per BTA student.
5. The use of tobacco/vaping/drugs/ controlled substances is prohibited.
6. The use of alcohol is prohibited.
7. Guests must be high school students in grades 11-12.
8. Formal attire is expected of all who attend.
9. Should a guest be asked to leave the event for unruly or unacceptable behavior, disciplinary follow-ups will occur by way of contacting administrators at the guests' school, security personnel at the prom site, or law enforcement, if appropriate.
10. A student or guest suspected to be under the influence, or found in possession of any substances will be sent home immediately with his/her parents/guardians and disciplinary action will be taken.
11. All bags may be searched. No bags larger than a purse/clutch will be allowed in the prom venue. Any backpacks or travel bags should be left outside.
